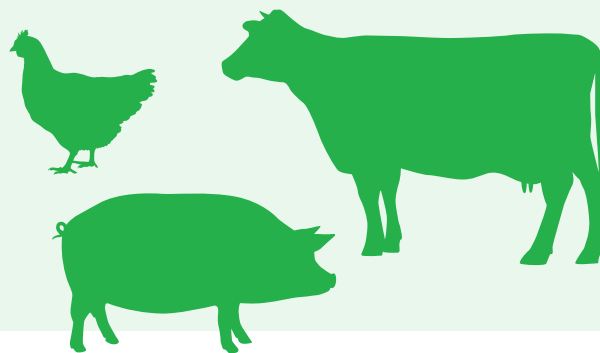


Sustainable livestock production

Sustainable livestock production is low-emission production, taking into account the improvement of animal welfare, reducing the use of antibiotics and ensuring the economic resilience of farms



Sustainable agriculture is all activities limiting the impact of agriculture on the environment while maintaining the profitability of agricultural production and its social acceptance

Practice:



care for **animal welfare**



use of antibiotics **only in the form of targeted treatment**



avoiding the use of **critical antibiotics** in treatment



animal feeding and husbandry systems that **minimize greenhouse gas emissions**



application of principles of **biosecurity**



purposeful and lawful **management of animal excrements**



compliance with health and safety regulations when handling animals and working on the farm

use of **valuable components of animal-derived fertilizers** to stimulate yields



mitigating climate change and reducing environmental losses



animal health improving **the profitability of production**
